

Amendments to the I-I District's Bylaws

Article VI Committees

Section 1. The titles and duties of this district's standing committees shall be as follows:

~~a. The Membership Development and Education committee shall cooperate with all of the clubs in this district to assist them in the maintenance of an adequate membership of appropriate standards, in the proper education and induction of new members, in the utilization of all members, in the development and attainment of minimum membership requirements, and in the promotion of the concept of regular attendance at club meetings.~~

~~b. a.~~ The K-Family Relations Committee shall work to improve the relationship between all Kiwanis and Kiwanis sponsored organizations. It shall be responsible for developing projects and educational programs to expand and strengthen the bonds between these organizations.

~~e. b.~~ The Spastic Paralysis Committee shall work to improve and promote the Spastic Paralysis Research Foundation. It shall be responsible for educating members, providing informational resources and promoting fundraising for the Foundation **along with assisting the Events Committee with Holiday Embrace.**

c. The New Club Building and Reactivation (NCB&R) Committee shall work to find new colleges or colleges that need reactivation that are willing and able to host Circle K clubs, build new clubs at those colleges and work with new leadership and faculty at the college(s) to ensure the club has a solid foundation.

d. The Technology Committee shall be in charge of maintaining the District website, www.iicirclek.org. It shall be responsible for ensuring that upcoming events are on the website, that online registration is working properly, and keeping the website up-to-date with accurate information regarding Circle K. In addition, it shall be responsible for assisting clubs in the creating of their websites.

e. The Events Committee shall be in charge of planning Leadership Training Conference, Holiday Embrace and District Convention.
